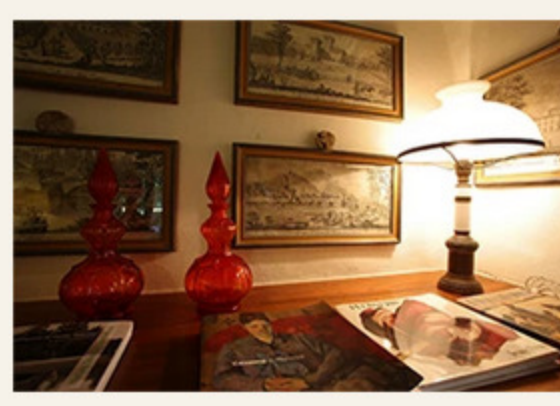

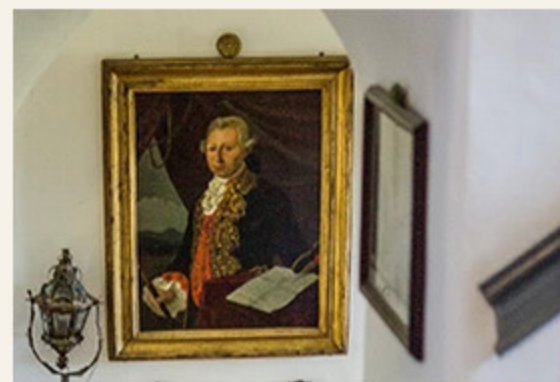
A 16th-Century Villa Steeped in Artistic Heritage

Even the **Chianti countryside** is filled with creativity—for example, the open-air **Chianti Sculpture Park** showcases contemporary art in a natural setting.

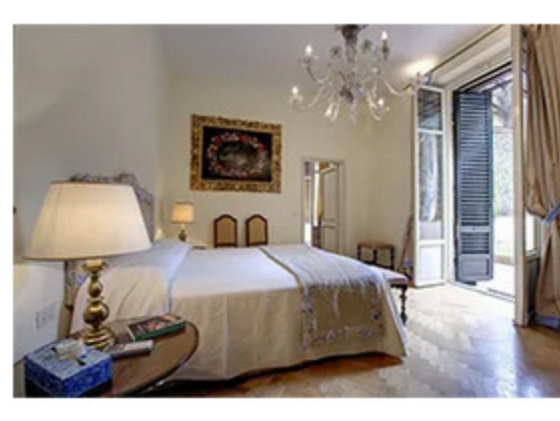

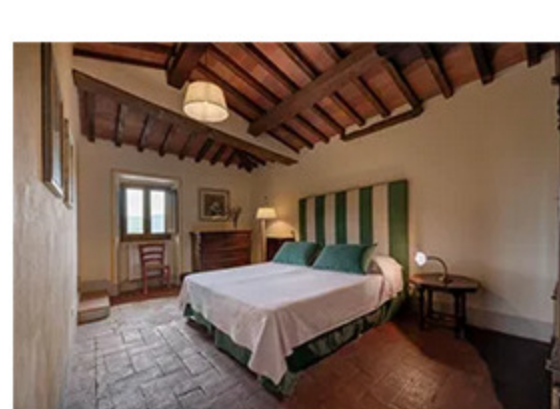
