Her daughter, **Duchess Franca Visconti**, opened the Villa as a luxury hotel in **1977**, ushering in a new era of refined hospitality.

Today, the hotel remains a proud member of the **Associazione Dimore Storiche Italiane (ADSI)**, preserving its rich legacy with care and authenticity.

The estate offers a wealth of leisure amenities, including a panoramic swimming pool, tennis court, fitness trail, and indoor fitness room. Fragrant rose gardens and Mediterranean flora frame sun-drenched terraces with breathtaking views over vineyards, olive groves, and the rolling Tuscan hills.

Dining at Villa Le Barone is a celebration of traditional Tuscan flavors. Meals, lovingly prepared by local Tuscan cooks, are served in the villa's former wine cellar or al fresco on the garden terrace. Rooms

Each room is uniquely decorated, featuring authentic antique furniture, fresh and tasteful fabrics, traditional terracotta floors, vintage prints, and exposed wooden beams that evoke the timeless spirit of Tuscany. Some rooms enjoy their own private terrace, while most offer enchanting views of the surrounding hills or manicured gardens.

Two rooms are of particular historic significance: the room of Marchesa Maria Bianca Viviani Della Robbia, which retains its original period furnishings; and a remarkable suite located in the ancient tower, adorned with 16th-century tapestries and overlooking the old estate's vineyards.

All rooms are equipped with air conditioning, satellite television, minibar, in-room safe, and high-speed internet access. Complimentary Wi-Fi is also available throughout the common areas and in most guest rooms.
